GET THE FACTS ON CANCER

- Hereditary cancer tends to occur at an earlier age than the sporadic form of the same cancer.
- Hereditary gene mutations can be passed on to children.
- Individuals who have inherited a gene mutation may be at a higher risk for more than one type of cancer. In people who have already been diagnosed with a cancer, this may affect their cancer treatment or follow-up care.
- Proven screening and risk-lowering options exist for individuals who know they are at high risk for certain types of hereditary cancer.
